CONSTITUENTS CONCERNS

Dump attendant Ann DuMonthier reported an altercation with previous employee, she reported that there were witnesses and a police report has been filed. A number of individuals attended meeting in regards to the proposed Campground on Price Lake. The owners of the proposed campground explained that it would be a quiet space, that will be supervised by them 24/7. There will be no RVs or 4 Wheelers or mini bikes allowed. There will not be any pit toilets, holding tanks will be put in if necessary. Owners also informed the group and board that as of this time they have not met with the DNR, once they meet the requirements of the DNR then it will go to Zoning so at this time it is still in the planning stages.

Several of the complaints were:

1. Is there a lake covenant?
2. People visiting have no stake in property so they don't care
3. Extra traffic on Pine Lake Road
4. People on Patton Lake were concerned that it may bring extra boat traffic to their lake
5. Who is going to take care of the campground?

Another question came from Tom T. asking about Aspen Lane Black Top and wanted to know who paid for it, Chairman Erwin stated that this was paid for by property owners. He also asked about the Logging Ordinance and wanted to know where its at. Chairman Erwin advised that it was being sent to Attorney to review.
